Acknowledging the need for multilateral cooperation in combating climate change,

Understanding that our countries' national interests are vital to our survival as separate and as functioning nations,

Hoping to maintain the balance between national autonomy and global collaboration,

- We propose the establishment of a subcommittee under UNESCO, called the BRICS+ committee, where;
 - Dealing with the effect of climate change on ecosystems will be determined primarily by each nation.
 - Cooperation between nations will occur in conjunction with perspectives that emphasize the importance of national autonomy before those of internationalist committees.
 - We will strive to deal with the effects of climate change, in the way that affects us
 - d. Work within the group to find common problems with climate change
- 2. We would like to establish a precedent by which national interests are considered with at least as much weight as those of the international community.
 - a. By doing so, we recognize the importance of patriotic sentiment and centralized government.
